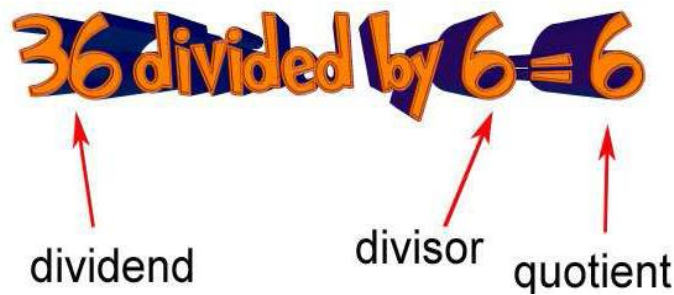


OPERATIONS

The four most basic operations in mathematics are:

Addition (+)	Multiplication (·)
Subtraction (-)	Division (÷)

Division



How do you say $12 : 3 = 4$?

$12 : 3 = 4$

- Twelve divided by three is four.
- Twelve divided by three equals four.
