- 4) My gran is twice as old as my mum, who is three times older than me. If my gran is 78 years old, how old am I?

- 5) A boy walks 2 km to a bus stop. He travels three times as far in the bus as he did on foot. How far does he travel in total?

- 6) When Hana makes jam he uses 2 kg of sugar for each 4 kg of fruit. If she has 10 kg of cherries, how much sugar will she need?

- 7) In a gym display there are 3 girls and 2 boys in each group. 39 girls take part in the display. How many boys are there altogether?
